### **Here's what we learned about groundhogs:**

Groundhogs eat plants, like dandelions and grass.

Groundhogs can climb trees.

Groundhog pups are born in a nursery room in the burrow.

Growing groundhog pups like to play games.

Groundhogs make a loud whistle to warn other groundhogs of danger. That tells the other groundhogs,

Groundhogs hibernate in burrows during cold winter months.

The groundhog's burrow also provides protection from enemies.

The groundhog's main entrance hole to the burrow is only 5 inches wide - just wide enough for a groundhog but too small for predators such as foxes or dogs.
